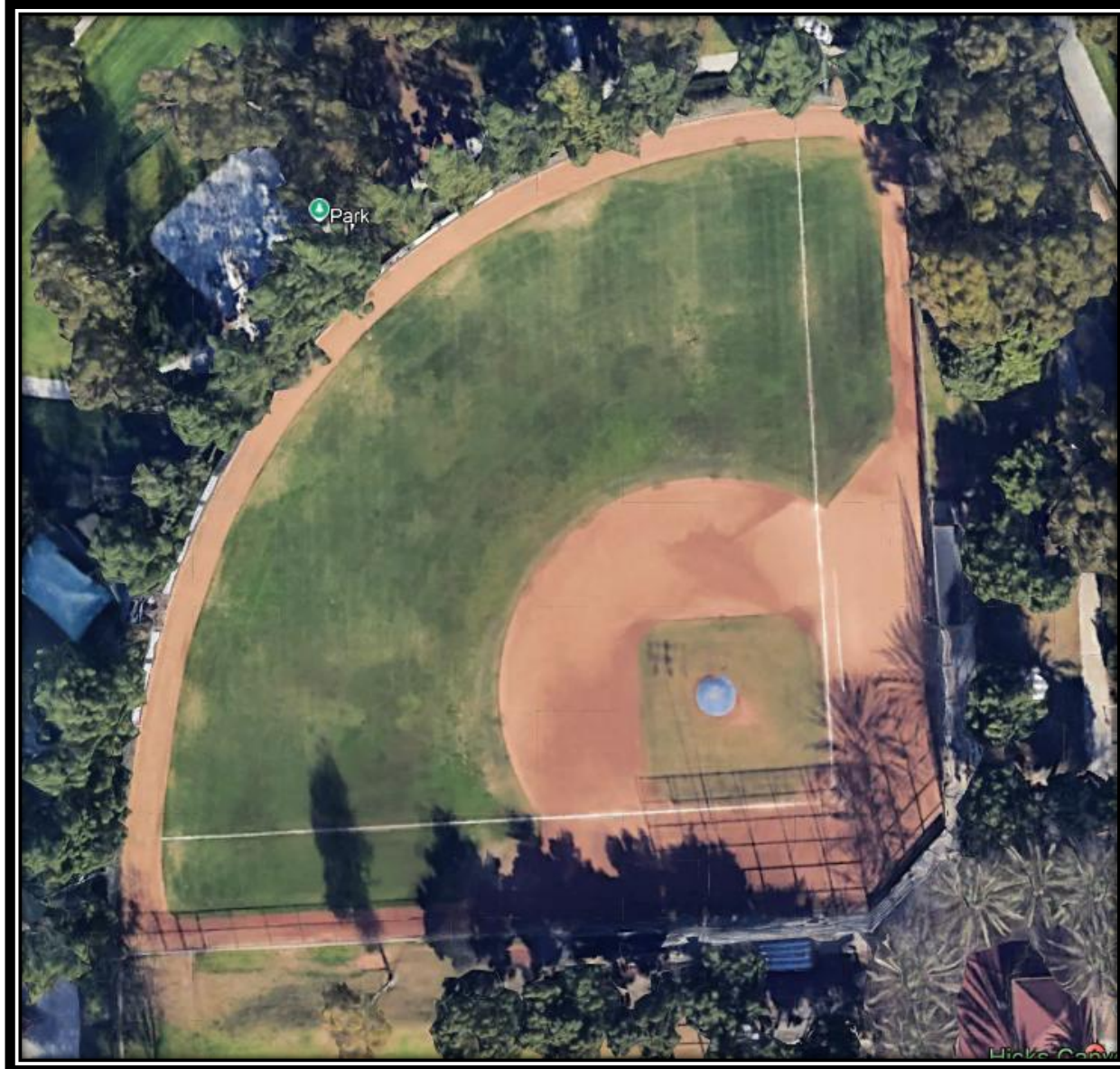


## Hick's Canyon Park, Field 1



### Ground Rules:

1. Home team in 3<sup>rd</sup> Base Dugout, Visiting Team in 1<sup>st</sup> Base Dugout.
2. Bullpens outside the fence line on each side.
3. Offense: Front gate closed during play, can use for in/out between batters. Back gate fully open, with no players standing in the opening or gate will be closed.
4. Defense: Front gate closed, back gate open with buckets/butts inside, feet hanging out to give signs acceptable. If no bucket, both feet inside. Ball hits bucket, person or goes into the dugout is a dead ball.
5. Ball lodged in padding in backstop is a dead ball.
6. Ball hits any part of tree overhanging the fence on a bounce is ground rule double, on the fly is home run.

## Hick's Canyon Park, Field 2



### Ground Rules:

1. Home team in 3<sup>rd</sup> Base Dugout, Visiting Team in 1<sup>st</sup> Base Dugout.
2. Bullpens outside the fence line on each side.
3. Offense: Front gate closed during play, can use for in/out between batters. Back gate fully open, with no players standing in the opening or gate will be closed.
4. Defense: Front gate closed, back gate open with buckets/butts inside, feet hanging out to give signs acceptable. If no bucket, both feet inside. Ball hits bucket, person or goes into the dugout is a dead ball.

6. Ball hits any part of tree overhanging the fence on a bounce is ground rule double, on the fly is home run.

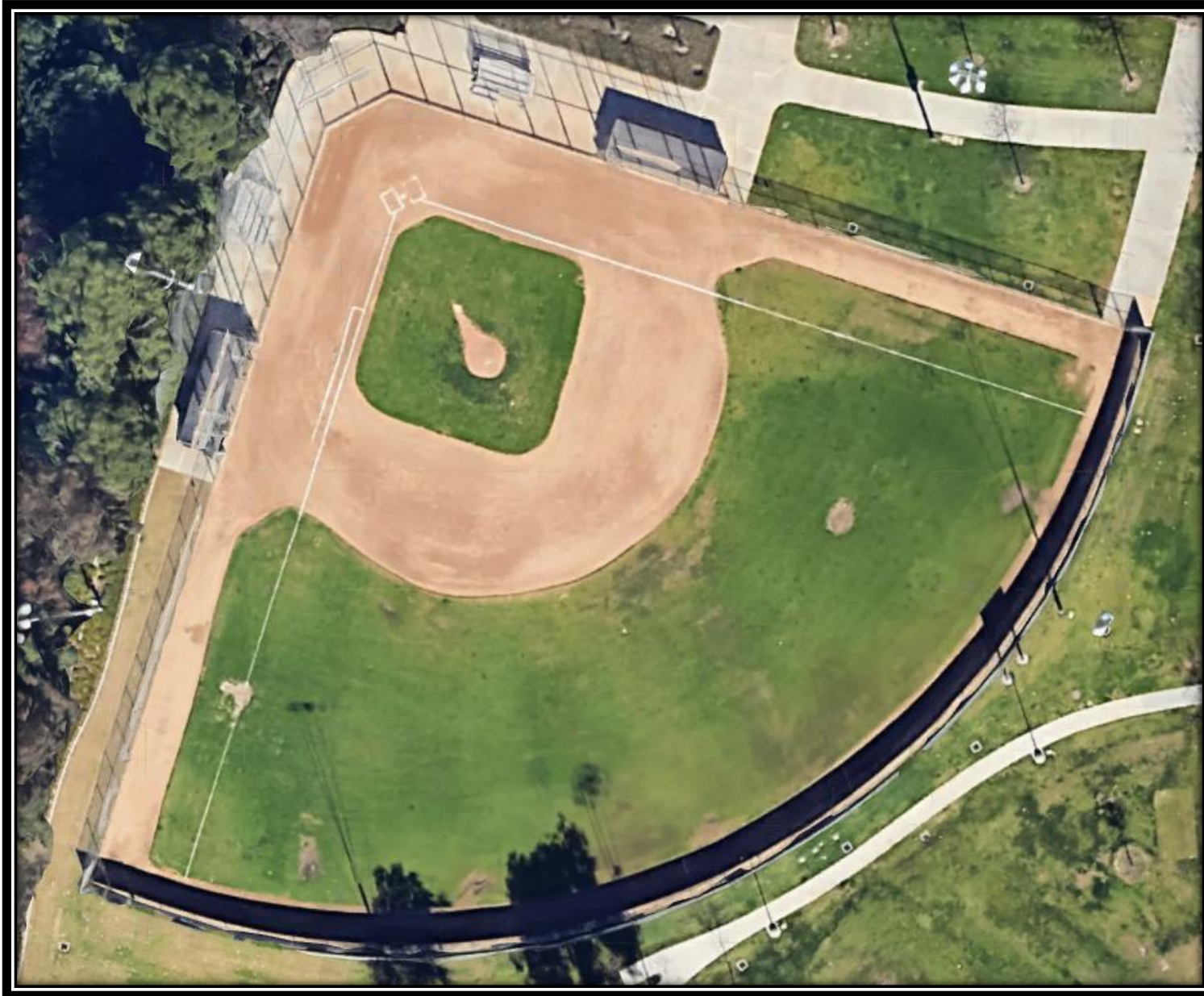
## Las Lomas Park, Field 1

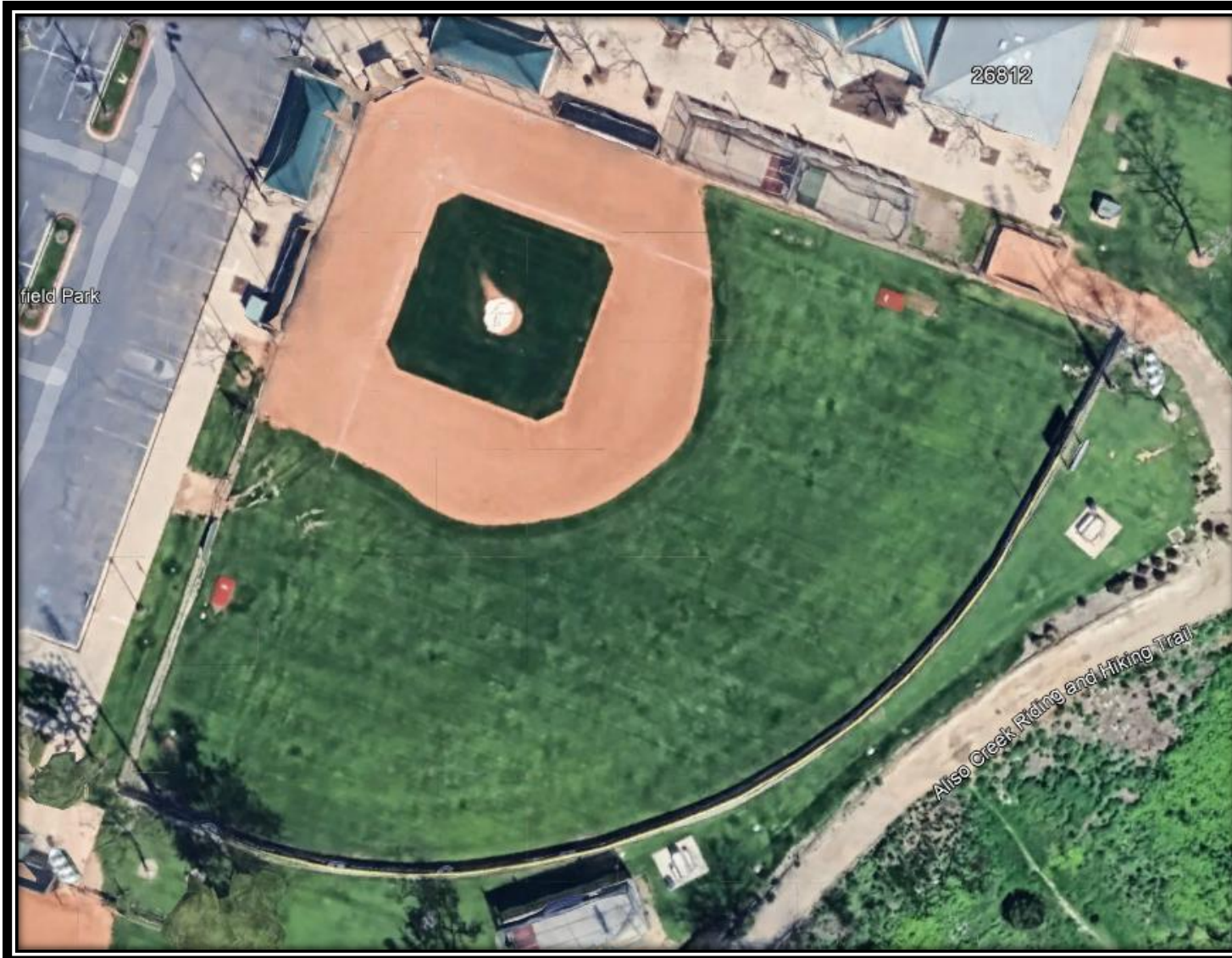
## Laguna Hills Community Center, Field 1



### Ground Rules:

1. Home team in 3<sup>rd</sup> Base Dugout, Visiting Team in 1<sup>st</sup> Base Dugout.
2. Bullpen areas are in-play, need spotter with helmet and glove. No loose baseballs.
3. Offense/Defense: Keep players out of opening. All coaches inside dugout. On defense, buckets/butts inside, feet hanging out to give signs acceptable. Ball hits bucket, person or goes into the dugout is a dead ball.
4. Ball lodged in padding in backstop is a dead ball.
5. Ball hits any part of tree overhanging the fence on a bounce is ground rule double, on the fly is home run.
6. Extend outfield fence perpendicular to foul line to determine out of play area.
7. Ball hits tarp, shrubs, container, or wall above shrubs, then dead ball.

## Woodfield Park, Field #4



### Ground Rules:

1. Home team in 3<sup>rd</sup> Base Dugout, Visiting Team in 1<sup>st</sup> Base Dugout.
2. Bullpen areas are in-play, need spotter with helmet and glove. No loose baseballs.
3. Offense/Defense: Front gate closed during play, okay to enter/exit on Offense. Back entrance, keep players out of opening. Defense, back entrance buckets/butts inside, feet hanging out to give signs acceptable. If no bucket, both feet inside. Ball hits bucket, person or goes into the dugout is a dead ball.
4. Ball lodged in padding in backstop is a dead ball.
5. Ball hits any part of tree overhanging the fence on a bounce is ground rule double, on the fly is home run.

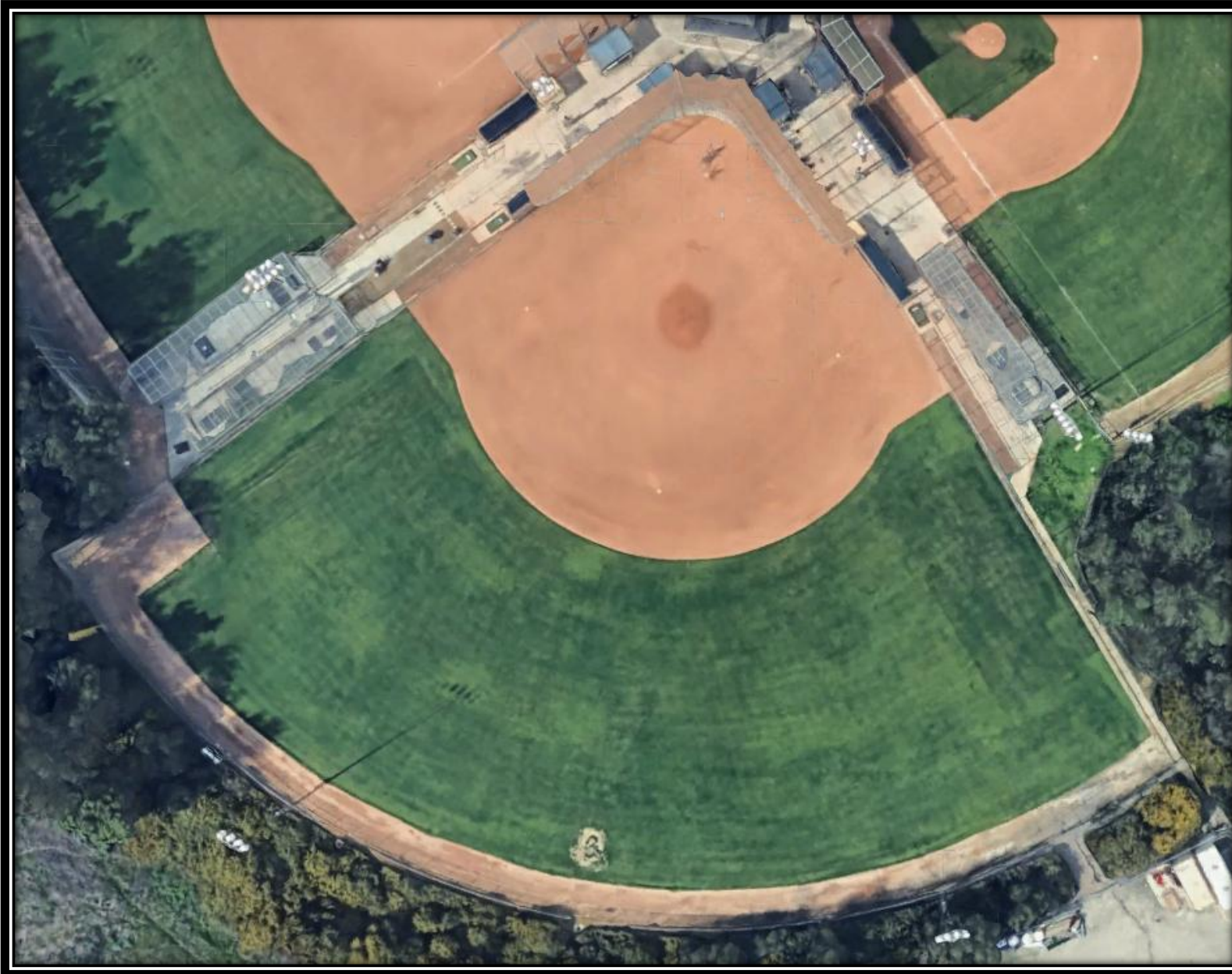
## Woodfield Park, Field #6

5. Ball hits any part of tree overhanging the fence on a bounce is ground rule double, on the fly is home run.

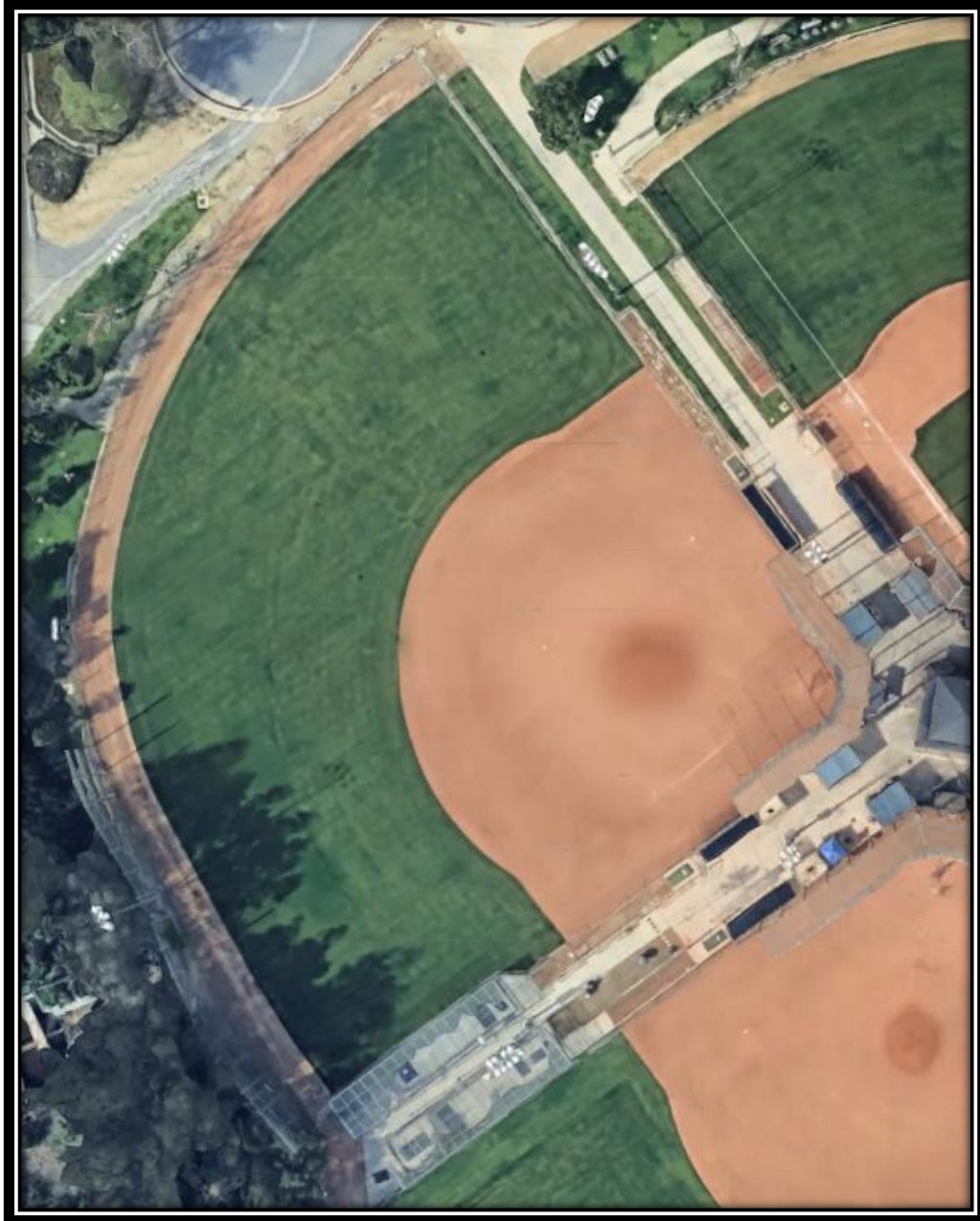

## Riddle Field, Field #1



### Ground Rules:

1. Home team in 3<sup>rd</sup> Base Dugout, Visiting Team in 1<sup>st</sup> Base Dugout.
2. Bullpens outside the fence line on each side.
3. Offense/Defense: Keep players behind the last pole of the dugout. A line drawn perpendicular from the last pole to the outer fence defines the end of the dugout and the beginning of the playing field. All coaches inside the dugout. On defense, one (1) bucket/butt just past the last pole to give signs is acceptable. Ball hits bucket, person or gets behind the person/bucket or past the line from the pole to the outer fence is a dead ball.
4. Ball lodged in padding in backstop is a dead ball.
5. Ball hits any part of tree overhanging the fence on a bounce is ground rule double, on the fly is home run.

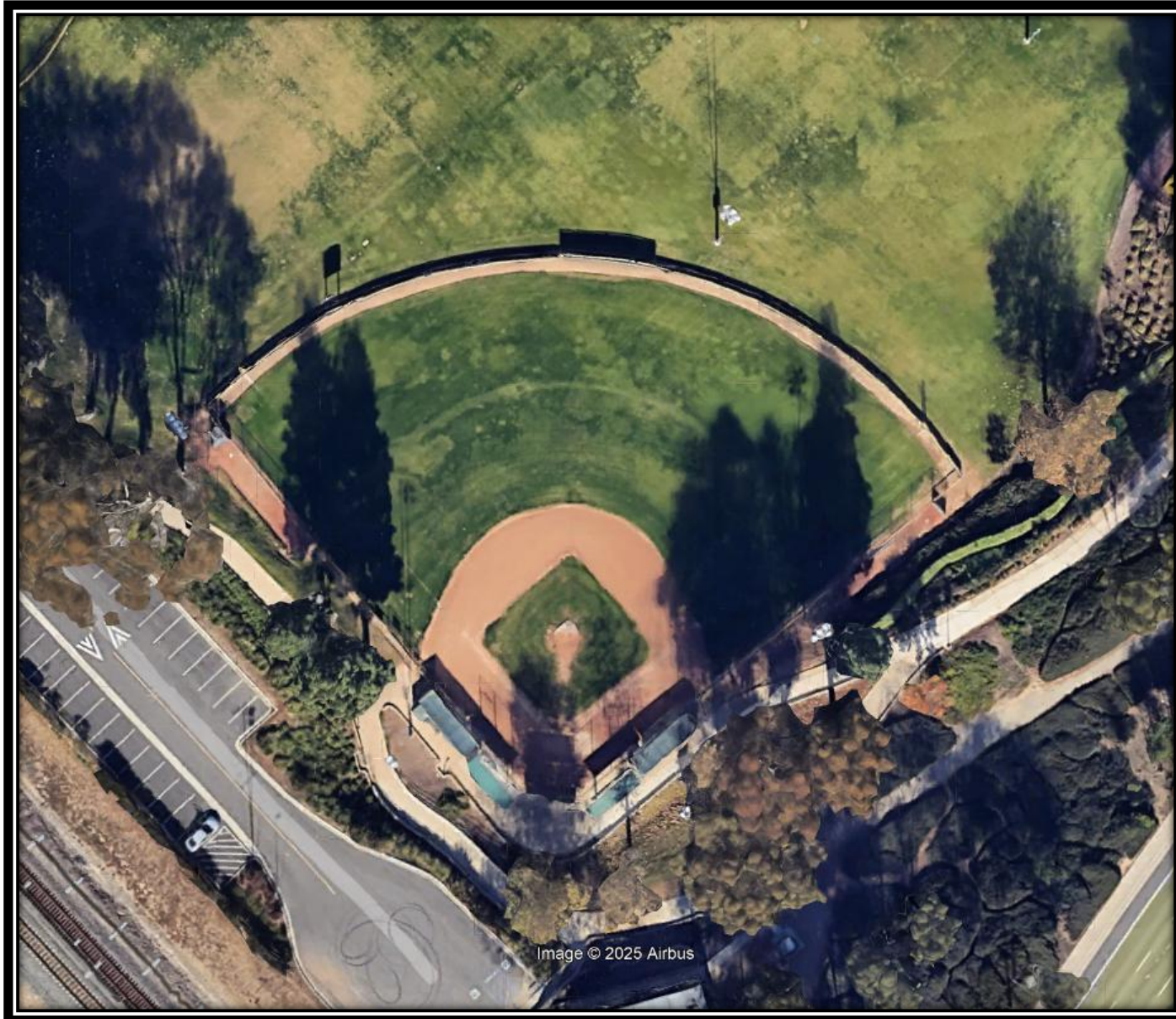
## Heroes Park, Field #2



### Ground Rules:

1. Home team in 3<sup>rd</sup> Base Dugout, Visiting Team in 1<sup>st</sup> Base Dugout.
2. Bullpens outside the playing area on each side. Gates to remain closed.
3. Offense/Defense: Keep players out of opening. Defense, buckets/butts inside, feet hanging out to give signs acceptable. If no bucket, both feet inside. Ball hits bucket, person or goes into the dugout is a dead ball.
4. Ball lodged in padding in backstop is a dead ball.
